Duties may include proposal preparation, field investigations, data analysis, managing subcontractors and discipline specialists, client coordination, preparation of environmental regulatory compliance documents, QA/QC reviews, and permitting support. Qualifications: Essential Qualifications:

Candidates should have a background in regulatory compliance and environmental permitting, with experience in transportation and oil/gas/energy projects a plus; be able to comfortably interact with clients and review agencies; be able to lead and support the analysis of environmental impacts; and be able to manage projects and/or tasks in a collaborative setting with multiple disciplines. Candidates should have proven experience providing a range of support to clients in a consulting environment.

Responsibilities will include field data collection and analysis; preparing environmental and permitting documents for infrastructure and other development projects in compliance with applicable governing statutes and implementing regulations; and providing support and risk assessment in the planning and implementation of major infrastructure projects. Experience Required:

The Hazardous Materials Project Manager shall be a qualified professional with 40-hour HAZWOPER certification and at least five years' experience in the following areas:

- Experience in preparation of Phase I ESAs;
- Experienced in developing IWP, SIRs, and remedial action plans or equivalent reports necessary and acceptable to the TCEQ in material discovery and remediation efforts of Hazardous Materials; and

- Experienced in TCEQ guidance for the investigation and remediation of Hazardous Materials under the TCEQ Voluntary Cleanup Program and Texas Risk Reduction Program rules.
- Working knowledge of environmental compliance requirements as they relate to public and private infrastructure projects;
- Position requires the flexibility to travel for project and field work;
- Position requires demonstrated skill in project and budget management, and commitment to QA/QC practices;
- The candidate must have excellent research, analytical, and writing/communication skill plus attention to detail and commitment to quality and professionalism. Must be a team player.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) a plus.

Education Required:

- BA/BS in Geology, Environmental Science, or a related field. Professional Geologist/Geoscientist preferred.
- Master's degree in pertinent field is preferred. Provide other certification and training information if available (Certified Hazardous Materials Manager, Professional Geologist, OSHA 40 hour, HAZWOPER, CPESC or CESSWI, etc...).
