• In the last several months, CMEC cultural resources staff members have completed **archaeological and historic resources surveys in 12 counties** for ~100 miles of proposed roadways, utility and electric transmission lines, and rail/airport expansions.

CMEC Biologists Busy with Endangered Bird Surveys

• Spring 2011 has been busy for our four biologists. We've conducted Golden-cheeked Warbler and Black-capped Vireo surveys on over 1,500 acres of central Texas lands. We've also conducted **construction noise monitoring** concurrent with bird surveys in an effort to assess potential impacts to rare species.
